If activity is what you are looking for, you'll find plenty of choices throughout Rockingham County's scenic parks.



The county's 17 public parks offer a variety of activities for the whole family from playgrounds, walking trails, tennis courts, championship baseball and softball fields, soccer fields, volleyball courts, paddle boating and picnic/event facilities. This area is also known for its great cycling terrain. With six designated bike routes, one of which includes the 100-mile Rockingham Challenge, the roads here provide varying degrees of difficulty for cyclists of all skill levels. The Chinqua-Penn Hiking Trail is one of the highlights of outdoor recreation in the county. It is located on the property of the historic estate between Reidsville and Wentworth. The trail features scenic, natural beauty and a number of historic points of interest.

Much of Rockingham County's heritage points to the importance of its greatest natural resource: water.



Much of Rockingham County's heritage points to the importance of its natural resources.

Like many other southeastern communities, Rockingham County's roots include Native Americans and European explorers, who were drawn to the rivers. Today, there are relics along the county's rivers that provide a glimpse into the lives of those early people. This area is the only place in North Carolina where you can see remainders of historic bateau boat systems and ride a replica bateau. (These boats were used in the 19th century for commercial river transportation and considered the 18-wheelers of that ear.)

The county's premier historical attraction is Chinqua-Penn Plantation, a 1920s English countryside mansion filled with elaborate furnishings from around the world. Other heritage sites include historic districts, a 19th century tavern and tours of the rug mill that made the 1928 "wonder rug."

Rockingham County is also proud to have seven sites on the North Carolina Civil War Trails in Eden, Madison, Reidsville and Wentworth.

HOMEGROWN

This area is proud of its farming, textile and tobacco heritage. But that era has faded and farmers and entrepreneurs alike are creating a new heritage for Rockingham County.

Vineyards and wineries are one example of new uses for vacated farms. Autumn Creek Vineyards in Mayodan is just seven miles off US 220 on a former farm. It features nearly 10 acres of vineyards, a tasting room, two overnight, get-away cabins, and plans for a special events center and inn. Chinqua-Penn Plantation is thriving off its heritage with the production of Chinqua-Penn wines and a wine tasting room. Riverbirch Vineyards is growing native Muscadine grapes and producing wine on another former farm in the countryside of Rockingham County.

This county's farming heritage is also celebrated through the Rockingham County Farmer's Market. The Farmer's Market is the perfect place to find some of the finest in home-grown, natural produce around. Located in the former stables of Chinqua-Penn Plantation, the market offers the best mix of heritage, scenic landscape and top-quality, farm-fresh produce, herbs and specialty foods. The market is open on Wednesdays and Saturdays from April to November. Downtown Reidsville also hosts the Downtown Farmer's Market in the Settle Street parking lot from May until November.
